

SWM BYE LAWS

Draft bye laws have been formulated for regulating the activities related To waste generation and disposal. These are as follows.

- 1) All the citizens shall segregate the Garbage into bio-degradable and Non bio-degradable , and store it into separate containers(Mandatory)
- 2) The segregated garbage shall be stored in a container preferably Green and Yellow respectively in front of their houses, and handed over to the person authorized by the commissioner.
- 3) No garbage shall be thrown on the roads or in open drains or open plots. The garbage generated by the generator commercial / residential shall dispose in the same way as specified by the Commissioner. Violation is punishable with a fine from Rs. 10 to 500 on the spot. The nodal officer or the ward officer is the implementing officer.
- 4) No garden waste shall be dumped on the roads or outside their premises. It is mandatory to have 6"x 6" pit and store the garden waste in such pits & convert it into manure or compost (vermiculture) , if desired details will be given by CCB. Violation will amount to penalty of Rs. 50 to 500.
- 5) Apartments or M.S buildings, institutions & schools shall store segregated waste in their own containers of required size. The dry waste shall be handed over to the CCB on the specified day as decided by the Commissioner. The service charges for them will be Rs 50/ month.
- 6) All families shall pay SWM cess to the service provider at the rate of Rs 20/month. Failure to do this action with penalty for non payment will be taken against the defaulter. Fine will range from Rs 20 for residential and 50 to 500 for commercial establishments.

- 7) No Industrial waste of any kind shall be put in the public dust bins violation is punishable with a fine from Rs 100 to 1000 Rs.
- 8) Persons running hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, shall dispose off their Bio-medical waste as per Bio-medical waste rules-2000. Hence it is directed to join "Association of medical hospitals and Nursing homes" which is already running bio-medical waste incineration unit. Violation is punishable with a fine from Rs. 100-1000 Rs.
